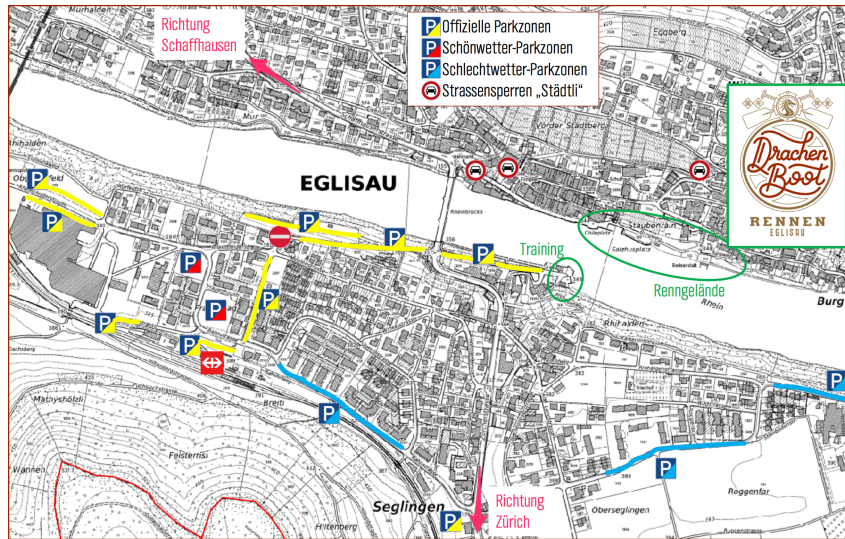

## HOW TO GET THERE / PARKING AREAS

Parking in Eglisau (10 CHF a day) during the Dragon Boat Race is very limited. We therefore, request that you consider car sharing and, if possible use public transport. In keeping with our good agreement with the local residents and the community, we kindly ask that all participants use the official parking spaces available (see map). Parking attendants will be placed on the 'Hauptstrasse' (the main road), to guide you. During the festival weekend the town is closed, and access is only given to local residents. Illegally parked vehicles will be towed away.

## COMPOSITION OF THE TEAMS

**Team** 16-20 paddlers are in the boat to provide power.  
1 drummer sets the pace and motivates the paddlers.

**Steersmen** Each boat will be steered by trained steersmen, whom will be provided by Dragonboat Club Eglisau.



## CATEGORIES

**Fun Mixed** There must be a minimum of 8 female paddlers in the boat. The drummer does not count as a paddler.

**Fun Women** The whole team must be female, with the exception of the drummer. (The drummer may be male).

**Fun Open** Open category. There are no gender restrictions.

**Schools** Mixed classes in the Secondary School.

## RACE SCHEDULE

Each team will receive a race schedule. These can be changed at short notice. Start times are fixed. Teams are requested to arrive at the boarding point 15 minutes prior to Start Time. Late arrivals will not be accommodated. Teams who miss a race will forfeit a penalty of the slowest 'time' plus an additional 5 seconds.

## RACE MODE FUN CATEGORY

Every race counts. Each result **will** be accounted for. The fastest 8 teams qualify for the semi-finals. Combined heat times are tallied. This is calculated using the results taken from the 3 preliminary heats (2 on Saturday, 1 on Sunday). The remaining fastest 4 teams (Mixed & Open) or the fastest combined times for the heats (Women) proceed to the finals. The course selection in the semi-finals or respective finals takes place according to the lead times.

## SAFETY

The Dragon Boat Race takes place on flowing waters and there is a considerable amount of water traffic. Capsizing of the boats is to be avoided at all times. Although safety measures are in place, code of conduct is to be respected. Please inform your team about the following behaviour rules.

### Code of Conduct:

1. Worn life jackets is compulsory.
2. The instructions of the steersmen, as well as the rescue team, must be followed at all times.
3. Use the paddle only for paddling. When not in use, the paddles must be supported horizontally on the boat's edge and water surface to stabilize the boat.
4. When crossing the finish line, paddle slowly and gradually.
5. Never stand up in the boat or jump over board.

6. The organizers strongly discourage paddling under the influence of alcohol or 'mind-altering' substances and will not accept any liability to any related incidents.



### Instructions to follow if capsized:

1. Check that your 'bench' neighbour is OK.  
(Drummer checks Steersman and vice versa)
2. Swim to the riverside or the nearest rescue boat.
3. Whole team assembles together on the riverside and reports to the race organizers.

### Swimming Ability

Team captains have confirmed through registration, that all members of their team are capable to swim 500 meters, fully clothed.

### Insurance

All participants are responsible for their own insurance.

### Equipment

Broken equipment always carries a safety risk. Please take good care of all boats, paddles and life jackets.

### Sanctions

Teams who do not follow rules or instructions may be disqualified. Teams who deliberately or negligently cause an incident will be disqualified.

Drunken individuals or those who appear to the steersmen to be of danger or disruption to others may be excluded from the team.



## INFORMATION ABOUT THE TRAININGS

- location: The training site is located at the Lochmühle in Eglisau (This is on the opposite side of the river to the church, see map).
- parking: Free parking is available on the Lochmühlestrasse. However, parking spaces are limited.
- attendees: In order for the training to take place, at least 12 team members must be present.
- times: The training sessions are run on a tight schedule. Please, therefore, arrive punctually.
- cloakrooms: There are public cloakrooms on site.
- meals: The DeliDonkey (food truck) will be on site to meet your hunger needs.

- returning empties to the food tent or at the bar (depot).

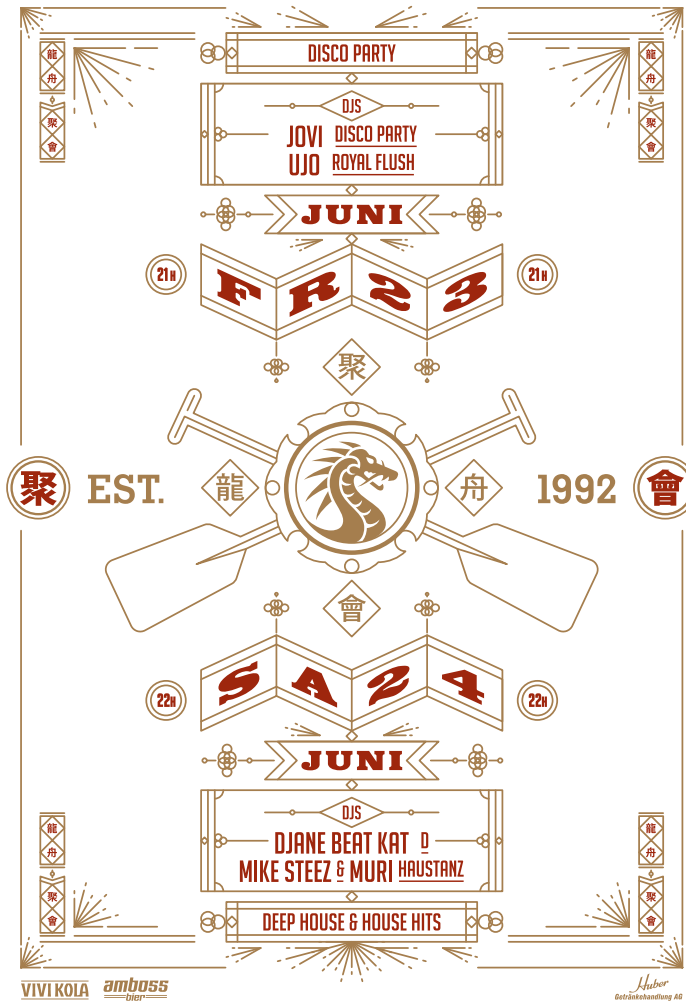
